- SET GOOD EXAMPLES THROUGH APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR AND GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP
- RECOGNISE AND VALUE COACHES/VOLUNTEERS FOR THE CONTRIBUTION THEY MAKE TO THE SPORT, RIDER AND CLUB
- SUPPORT ALL EFFORTS TO REMOVE ABUSIVE/BULLYING BEHAVIOUR THAT INSTILS FEAR IN OTHERS
- SEEK TO SUPPORT ALL EFFORTS TO ENSURE THE CLUB'S AIMS TO BE INCLUSIVE TO RIDERS OF ALL ABILITIES
